

Art Basel Names a Record 88 Projects for 2016 Unlimited Sector

Art Basel Unlimited

The Unlimited platform at this year's Art Basel in Basel will present a record 88 projects spanning six decades from galleries participating in the fair. Art Basel's sector for artworks that transcend the traditional art fair stand is curated for the fifth straight year by Gianni Jetzer, curator-at-large at the Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden in Washington D.C.

Presented across 16,000 square meters of exhibition space and encompassing large-scale sculptures, video projections, installations, wall paintings, photographic series, and performance

art, Unlimited showcases new work by living artists alongside Modern works of historical significance, establishing an overview of both Modern and contemporary art.

Unlimited’s continued embrace of the globalism of the art world is evident in the range and scope of video and multi-media works being presented a part of this year’s platform, which includes pieces by India’s Archana Hande, China’s Yan Xing and Cheng Ran, Brazilian artist Paulo Nazareth, Singapore’s Ho Tzu Nyen, and Samson Young of Hong Kong.
